COMMUNITY ASSEMBLY REPORT TO LINCOLN HEIGHTS NEIGHBORHOOD COUNCIL

Council Woman Amber Waldref reported that the Red Light contract is up for potential renewal after 5 years. There is currently an investigation of collisions and indicators of intersection safety. Those results will go to the City Council for review and possible renewal.

PeTT Committee:

- 1) Freight and Truck Routes Resolution passed by City Council.
- 2) Tattle Tail Lights passed by Community Assembly April 5th.
- 3) The committee needs opinion of Neighborhoods on the Street Bond Phase #2. What should be included in the bond? The Citizens Streets Advisory Committee has asked Neighborhood Councils their opinion on their preference for emphasis on street repair versus complete streets or a combination of both.

CA NPAC will ask the 10 remaining neighborhoods which have not planned if they would like to pool funds and hire a planner (as was done in the South Hill Coalition). Luke Tolley has suggested that planning neighborhoods attend meetings but it is not required.

Ken Pelton, City Planning, discussed Comprehensive Plan updates. Detailed information can be found at <u>www.spokaneplanning.org</u>. There will be a public comment period for each. Further discussion will occur at tonight's meeting.
