Urban Farming – Council President Ben Stuckart

He has drafted Urban Farming Regulation changes, working on changes in the city code on animal restrictions and proposing to increase the number of small domestic animals at a residence (i.e. hens and other "small livestock"). There will be an Urban Farming open house and he has developed a working group (advisory team). A pilot market program in 5 CD neighborhoods will be proposed permitting sale of fruits, vegetables and eggs grown or raised on site. Fairchild Air Force Base Encroachment – Al French

There will be a 2nd ballot measure for the funding to remove houses on the encroachment (last encroachment to be removed) for planes in and out of Fairchild. Fairchild is the region's number 1 employment site with approximately 6,000 military and civilian employees and economically very important to the community.
